- Large class sizes created need for alternative methods of assessment






Group Piano Classes

- Fully online (non-majors)
- Hybrid (music majors)

Non-major: fully online

- Mostly asynchronously
- Students own or borrow USB keyboard
- Instructor videos on Canvas LMS
 - Camtasia, Filmora, or Screenflow
- Regular video submissions
- <u>Piano Marvel</u>: interactive collection of pieces
 - Obtain specific grades







Non-major: fully online

- •Video exchanges facilitated with:
 - Canvas (LMS)
 - Closed Facebook groups
 - Google Drive
 - Collabra Music (collabramusic.com)
 - MusicU (CU Boulder soon available to others)







Music majors: hybrid approach


- Subgroups of 4 students
